



Boral 14mm overlay solid strip flooring

Boral 14mm overlay solid strip flooring is a non-structural hardwood overlay flooring profile designed to be glued down directly over level, clean, dry and flat solid structural subfloors such as existing timber flooring or plywood.

Boral 14mm overlay provides the option of direct sticking a wide board without top nail marks allowing for a smooth even finish.

Features and benefits

- As it is only 14mm thick it is excellent for matching to the level of other floor coverings such as tiles and carpet.
- This solid overlay flooring product is precision-milled to 14mm thick with a wear layer of 4mm. This is the same depth of wear as Boral Timber's more traditional 13mm overlay product, allowing for a number of sand and finishes to the floor over its lifetime.
- Boral overlay is straight-line profiled using state of the art European equipment to ensure stability and excellent product quality.
- The company's best practice kiln drying techniques ensure consistently accurate drying for a stable product.
- Boral 14mm overlay is designed with no underside glue grooves for greater surface area contact between the timber and the subfloor and therefore better adhesion.
- Boral 14mm overlay is individually wrapped in small bundles for easy site management.
- All Boral Timber hardwood products are Australian Forestry Standard (AFS) Chain of Custody certified making them an environmentally responsible choice.

Installation requirements

Boral 14mm overlay solid timber flooring is designed to be glued down over level, clean, dry and flat solid structural subfloors such as plywood or existing timber floors.

Grade

Standard and Better grade – a mix of Boral Timber's Classic and Australiana grades providing a combination of low level and moderate level feature boards.

Natural grade – Rustic grade displaying a high level of natural feature.

Species available

Australian Beech, Blackbutt, Forest Reds, Sydney Blue Gum and Spotted Gum.

Length and packaging specs

Boral 14mm overlay is supplied on a pallet that includes bundles of random length boards.
